Purpose

Website accessibility is the practice of ensuring that people with disabilities are able to access and use the content and functional components of a website. The goal is to ensure that users with any range of abilities and disabilities can use your website as easily as possible. Disabilities that can affect a person's ability to interact with a website include (but are not limited to) blindness, color blindness, and low vision; partial or complete hearing loss; limited mobility and loss of movement; and cognitive, developmental, and psychiatric conditions.

Process

Gravity Works followed the **Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) version 2.1, level AA** set of standards when evaluating your website. We use a mix of automated tools that check website code along with a manual review by our accessibility team. When an error is encountered that does not meet compliance with accessibility guidelines, we first identify whether the issue is the result of code or content. Code changes are sent to our development team to be resolved. Content changes are either resolved by our content team, or they are listed below as

recommended changes for your team to make. For this audit, your entire website was reviewed with automated tools. Additionally, the following pages were checked manually by Gravity Works.

Results

The following issues were flagged, to be sent to the development team for resolution. Unless indicated otherwise, Gravity Work has resolved the following:

Issue	Description
Landmarks	Landmarks must be uniquely identifiable, and all content must be contained in landmarks. Complementary landmark must be top level. No more than one banner landmark.
Headings	Headings properly nested and within landmarks.
Style/Content	Empty links and empty headings found. Minor adjustments for color contrast ratio.
Forms/Controls	Id must be unique. Search form control had more than one label associated with it.
Images	Missing alt text.
Tables	Identify table markup as data or layout on the executive education page.
